## Activity

**What If . . .**

**What You Need:**

No supplies needed

**What You Do:**

Invite your child to do an activity with you. Say, "How do you think you might see things differently if one of these situations happened to you?"

Give your child the following scenarios, and allow them to describe how it might make them see things differently:

- You could only see for one hour every day
- No one had a Bible
- You could be your parent or stepparent for a day
- You saw Jesus in real life when you were walking out of church today
- You were a millionaire

Then ask, "Think of some things you believe are true about Jesus. How would life be different if one of those things WEREN'T true?" Allow your child to respond. If they need some help, give them the following scenarios to respond to.

How would it affect their faith if . . .

- God was not everywhere at all times
- Jesus never came to Earth
- Jesus never rose from the dead
- God loved some of us more than others

When you're finished, say, "I'm so glad we don't have to live in a world where any of those scenarios are true! Like Saul, we can have BIG faith in Jesus. We can believe that Jesus came to be our Savior!"

## Talk About the Bible Story

What are some things that you know about Jesus?

What is something you've heard others say about Jesus but you're not sure if it's true or not?

When you have questions about Jesus, where can you go to find answers? Who can you talk to?

A follower of Jesus sees things differently than someone who doesn't have faith in Jesus. What are some ways that might show up in the following areas?

- money
- relationships
- sickness or death
- time
- creativity
- happiness
- Bible

*Parent: Share about a time when knowing Jesus changed how you saw things. Maybe you were facing a challenge in your life, or maybe you were having trouble getting along with someone . . . but you saw the situation differently because of your faith in Jesus.*

## Prayer

**Use this prayer as a guide while you pray. Talk to God about the Bible story as you pray. You can pray before bed or right tonight:**

"Jesus, there are so many things we can praise You for. The more we learn about You, the more our faith grows. Help us to keep following You even when it's hard. We need Your help to see things the way You see them, and to trust You no matter what. Amen."
